In consideration of myself and/or my child, participation in IAA's, Train different, and OG Performance Training 3 on 3 and King of the Court Basketball tournament on August 21st, 2021, at the Carole Hoefener Center located in Charlotte, NC, I hereby agree on behalf of myself, my heirs, legates, executors, administrators, and personal representatives, to release and hold harmless all staff and coaches, and any and all other persons and organizations assisting IAA, Train Different, and OG Performance Training from liability for any injury to my child or myself, to myself and/or my child's property and any and all claims in any manner arising from or associated with myself and/or my child's participation whether the liability, loss or damage is caused in whole or in part by their failure to use reasonable care in their activities associated with the basketball tournament. I understand that in case of emergency, IAA, Train Different, and OG Performance Training staff and all other coaches and/or volunteers have my total permission to use their best judgment in matters of treatment and to have my child treated accordingly.

I hereby assume all of the risks of participating in this event.

I understand that at this event or related activities I may be photographed. I agree to allow my photo, video, or film likeness to be used for any legitimate purpose by the event holders, producers, sponsors, organizers, and/or assigns.

Identification for each player in the Elite 1 league (ages 14-18) (e.g. birth certificate driver's license, other photo ID, etc...) is required at on-site registration to verify information provided on the original application (i.e. age). Eligibility problems will be enforced from point of discovery. No replay of games or adjustments will be allowed for previous contests and standing involving the team/player in question.

Please note that inappropriate language and/or behavior directed at players, officials, volunteers, or event organizers will not be tolerated. Only one warning will be given. If the incident reoccurs, the adult(s) and/or player(s) involved will be asked to leave.

All high school and college players are encouraged to check with their coaches and/or athletic directors about participating in the tournament and the potential effects on their eligibility. Event organizers are not responsible for determining a particular athlete's eligibility under National Collegiate Athletic Association or applicable high school association rules.

Event organizers and designated tournament officials shall have the power to make all decisions on any points not specifically covered in the Rules & Regulations and shall have the sole authority to interpret the intent and purpose of these Rules & Regulations. Event organizers and designated tournament officials reserve the right to disqualify any player and/or team for infractions of tournament rules and policies.
